- «Try» ⇒ quando parli di cose difficili (he tried to solve that problem, but he couldn't do it)
- «Start» ⇒ indifferente
- «Stop» ⇒ usato per uno scopo (i stopped to drink a coffee → I went to a café and got a coffee)

VERBI+GERUNDIO

- «Forget» and «Remember»⇒ quando parli di cose che dovevi fare nel passato (i don't remember meeting him at the party)
- «Try» ⇒ quando parli di esperimenti con qualcosa (I tried taking a meditation class, but it wasn't for me)
- «Start» ⇒ indifferente
- «Stop» ⇒ quando agisce su altri verbi (Please stop talking; I can't stop reading this book)
